

Family Camping Trip Sample Itinerary

April 30 through May 1, 2021

Check-in: Friday, April 30th at 2 PM – **Check-out:** Sunday morning, May 1st at 12 PM

***Please note that this itinerary is subject to change as we work together to plan. All registered families will receive the final itinerary in their camp preparation info packet (to be sent out a week before our trip).

***** If you are interested in reserving a site or cabin, your campsite or cabin fees are due by Fri., April 9th at Noon. SEND PAYMENTS VIA ZELLE TO MELANIE AT (972) 672-2739 in the notes section indicate cabin or tent and the number of people. If you will have multiple tents, you will need to calculate your fees accordingly.**

Cost:

Option 1: \$50 PER TENT (covers the camp site for 2-nights, \$25 a night). There are two tents per campsite, so you can let us know who you would like to share sites with (*See the list of those who expressed an interest below*).

Upon arrival there is a REFUNDABLE \$100 deposit due per site or cabin rental. You and your campsite buddy will need to decide how this will be paid. Either one person can pay the full amount, or one person can send their half to the other person to pay it. AGAIN, THE \$100 IS REFUNDABLE, if you clean up after yourselves and don't damage anything.

Option 2: \$190 for a small cabin for 2 nights (\$95 a night)

Option #3: \$220 for a medium cabin for 2 nights (\$110 a night)

Food, Drinks and Snacks:

Bryan and Melanie, are graciously providing breakfast Saturday and Sunday morning.

If anyone is interested in doing so, we can collect money and I can go to the store to purchase items for lunch and dinner to cook over a campfire.
